List of banks and shops where you can cash your travelers checks and exchange currencies.

BTM (Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi) Ueno Branch

9am – 3pm weekdays / closed for weekends

Nakaokachimachi / subway Hibiya line, Okachimachi / JR Yamanote line

BTM Kaminarimon Branch

9am – 3pm weekdays / closed for weekends

Asakusa / subway Ginza line, Asakusamatsuyamae / #42 bus

The above banks are within 30 minutes from JUYOH HOTEL.

Most of the BTM banks do the same money exchange business. But note that their business hours are limited.

South Exit of JR Shinjuku station 11am – 7:30pm

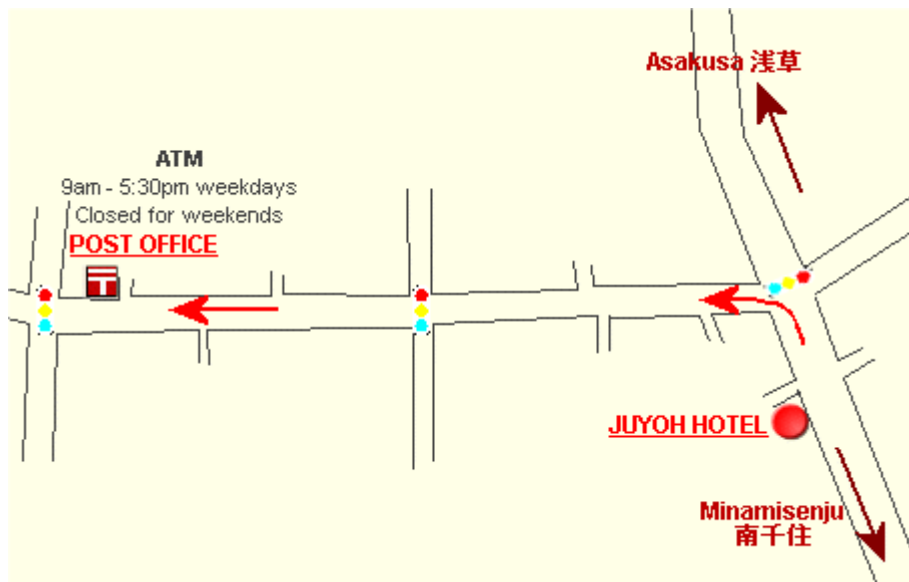
There are some more World Currency Shops in busy areas of Tokyo. You might find one in Shibuya, Ikebukuro, Yurakucho and Roppongi.



ATMs for International Credit Cards

ATMs of POST OFFICE accept credit cards issued in foreign countries. Foreign credit, debit and cash cards can be used at over 21,000 Post Office ATMs.

The nearest post office is 6 minutes walk from our hotel.



Note that the business hours of post office is very limited;

9am-5:30pm only on weekdays

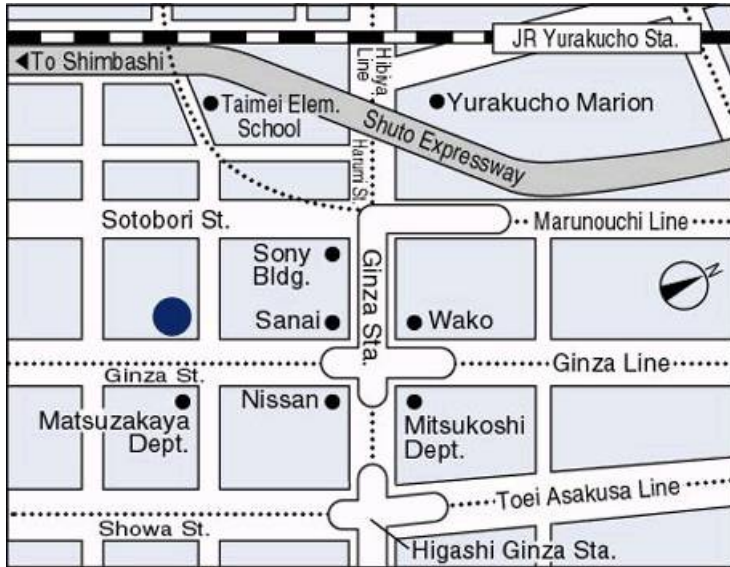
Shinsei Bank ATM; ATM available 365days 7am-2am
