

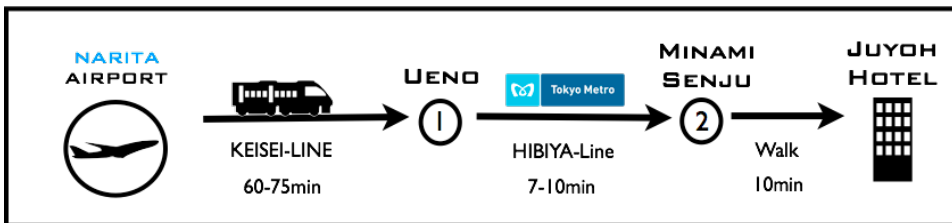
MAPS & Useful Phrases

Welcome to Japan!!

If you are not familiar about Japan, you would better to know at least how to get to your first place to stay! So here's the direction from the Airports to the JUYOH HOTEL and some useful phrases to ask someone about directions. Good Luck!!

Narita Airport

The main Airport of Tokyo is Narita International Airport. It's actually bit far from Tokyo, and It takes about 1 hour to the closest part in Tokyo, and We are in the closest location. Here's the Direction from the Narita Airport to the JUYOH HOTEL.

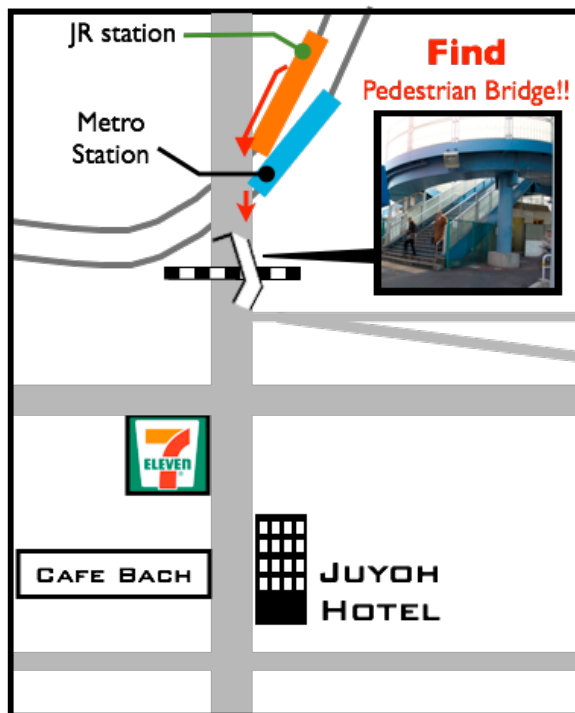


The closest station (Minami-Senju) to the JUYOH HOTEL

Our BIGGEST Advice is FIND the pedestrian bridge FIRST!!

There is 3 stations in Minami-Senju. (One is very tricky one, so just 2 stations are on the Map.) Either of them you come out of, the first thing you have to do is find the pedestrian bridge like the photo in the Map!!

As you see on the Map, the way from the TOKYO METRO's Minami-Senju Station is the simplest, so we suggest you get to Minami-Senju by Tokyo Metro!!

- Hello / *Konnichiwa*
- Excuse me / *Suimasen*
